

PRIVACY POLICY

CentraleSupélec's head management is concerned with protecting the privacy and data of its students. Thus, it makes sure to adopt and enforce a data processing policy in accordance with the regulations in force.

As such, CentraleSupélec complies with the applicable European law on the protection of personal data, and in particular the General European Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data No. 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (known as "RGPD / GDPR") as well as all the rules of national law adopted in application of the latter, in the alternative, and which may apply, as the case may be.

The purpose of this Privacy Policy (the "Charter") is to provide clear, simple and complete information to the persons concerned ("you" or "your") about how CentraleSupélec, in its capacity as of data controller, collection and use of personal data about you ("personal data") and the means you have to control such use and exercise your rights thereto.

1. When are your personal data collected?

CentraleSupélec is required to collect your personal data as part of your registration and throughout your schooling within the School.

The personal data available to the School, with some exceptions, are those that you provide via forms, whether they are paperless, in paper format or in response to questions put to you by your contacts in the Studies Department. CentraleSupélec takes into account the principles of minimizing data, protecting data from the outset and protecting data by default. As a result, relevant, adequate and limited information is collected that is necessary for the purpose for which it is processed.

Mandatory declarative personal data is indicated by an "*" sign on the collection medium. Apart from these cases, you are free to provide all or part of your personal data. However, such a decision could have the effect of limiting your access to certain services offered by CentraleSupélec, or other functionality offered by its websites and mobile applications.

2. On what legal basis your data are collected ?

Your personal data are processed by CentraleSupélec in the cases permitted by the applicable regulations, and in particular under the following conditions:

- When you have expressed free, specific, informed and unambiguous consent regarding the processing of your personal data (eg registration for an event ...)
- When it is necessary for the instruction of your registration and the follow-up of your schooling;
- For compliance with CentraleSupélec's legal or regulatory obligations;
- When the legitimate interests of CentraleSupélec may be of a nature to warrant treatment by it (eg quality approach, IT security measures).

Information in accordance with the applicable law is provided in each case.

3. Why are your personal data collected?

Your personal data is collected for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes.

Depending on the case, CentraleSupélec's studies department may use your personal data for administrative purposes or for any other purpose imposed by current legislation or our relations with institutional partners (CTI, CGE, etc.).

4. Who are the recipients of your personal data?

Your personal data being confidential, only persons duly authorized by CentraleSupélec, and in particular reporting to the Direction of Studies CentraleSupélec (teachers, staff of the Directorate of Education, the administrative pole of the Directorate of Studies and the Director of Studies) may access your personal data, without prejudice to their possible transmission to the institutions in charge of a control or inspection mission in accordance with the applicable regulations.

All persons having access to your personal data are bound by a confidentiality obligation.

Our service providers may also be required to process personal data strictly necessary for the performance of the services we entrust to them (mission, electronic and postal distribution, logistics and catering, etc.).

In case of recourse to affiliates or service providers located outside the European Union, CentraleSupélec undertakes to check that appropriate measures have been put in place to ensure that your personal data benefit from a level of adequate protection (through standard European Commission contract clauses, Internal Company Rules or the Data Protection Shield set up between the European Union and the United States).

5. How is the security of your personal data preserved?

CentraleSupélec ensures the protection and security of your personal data to ensure their confidentiality and prevent them from being distorted, damaged, destroyed or disclosed to unauthorized third parties.

When the disclosure of data to third parties is necessary and authorized, CentraleSupélec ensures that these third parties guarantee the data concerned the same level of protection offered to them by CentraleSupélec, and requires contractual guarantees so that, in particular, the data is exclusively processed for the purposes that you have previously accepted, with the necessary confidentiality and security.

CentraleSupélec implements technical and organizational measures to ensure that personal data are stored securely and for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes pursued in accordance with applicable law.

Although CentraleSupélec takes reasonable measures to protect your personal data, no transmission or storage technology is completely foolproof.

In accordance with the applicable European regulations, in the event of a proven violation of the Personal Data that may create a high risk for the rights and freedoms of the persons concerned, CentraleSupélec undertakes to communicate this violation to the competent supervisory authority and, where this is required by the said regulations, to the persons concerned (individually or generally depending on the case).

Without prejudice to the above, it is your responsibility to exercise caution to prevent unauthorized access to your personal data and your devices (computer, smartphone, tablet, ...).

In addition, CentraleSupélec's websites may offer links to websites of third parties that may be of interest to you. CentraleSupélec has no control over the content of these sites of third parties or the practices of these third parties in the protection of personal data they may collect. Consequently, CentraleSupélec declines all responsibility concerning the processing by these third parties of your Personal Data, not subject to this Policy. It is your responsibility to inform yourself about the privacy policies of these third parties.

6. How long is your personal data kept?

CentraleSupélec keeps your personal data for the time necessary to achieve the purposes pursued, subject to the legal possibilities of archiving, data retention obligations, and / or anonymization.

In particular, we apply the following retention periods for your Personal Data: the time required to process your application and then until the end of the schooling.

7. What are your rights to your personal data and how to exercise them?

7.1. Your rights

Subject to the limits provided by the regulations in force, you have the following rights in respect of your personal data:

Right of information on the processing of your personal data

CentraleSupélec strives to provide you with concise, transparent, understandable and easily accessible information in clear and simple terms, on the conditions of the processing of your personal data.

Right of access, rectification and erasure (or "right to forget") of your personal data

The right of access allows you to obtain from CentraleSupélec the confirmation that your personal data are or have not been processed, and the conditions of this processing, as well as to receive an electronic copy (for any additional copy, CentraleSupélec is entitled to require possible payment of reasonable fees based on the administrative costs incurred).

You also have the right to obtain from CentraleSupélec, as soon as possible (and by default, 30 days), the correction of your personal data.

Finally, subject to the exceptions provided for by the applicable law (retention required to comply with a legal obligation), you have the right to ask CentraleSupélec for the deletion, as soon as possible, of your Personal Data, when one of the following reasons apply:

- Your personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
- You wish to withdraw your consent on which the processing of your personal data was based and there is no other basis for this treatment;
- You consider and can establish that your personal data has been subject to unlawful processing;
- Your personal data must be erased under a legal obligation.

Right to limit the processing of your personal data

The applicable regulations provide that this right may be invoked in certain cases, in particular the following: when you dispute the accuracy of your personal data; when you consider and can establish that the processing of personal data is illegal but that you oppose the erasure of personal data and require the limitation of treatment instead; when CentraleSupélec no longer needs your personal data but you still need it for the purposes of ascertaining, exercising or defending legal rights; when you oppose the treatment which would be based on the legitimate interest of the controller, during the verification as to whether the legitimate grounds pursued by the data controller take precedence over those of the data subject.

Right to portability of personal data

When the processing is based on your consent or contract, this right to portability allows you to receive personal data that you have provided CentraleSupélec in a structured format, commonly used, and to transmit this personal data to another controller without CentraleSupélec obstructing it.

When technically possible, you may request that this personal data be sent directly to another controller by CentraleSupélec.

Right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data

When CentraleSupélec processes your personal data because of your consent, it may be withdrawn at any time using the means at your disposal for this purpose (procedure indicated in point 7.2 of this Policy). On the other hand, and in accordance with the applicable law, the withdrawal of your consent is valid only for the future and cannot therefore call into question the lawfulness of the treatment carried out before this withdrawal.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

If, despite CentraleSupélec's efforts to protect the confidentiality of your personal data, you believe that your rights are not respected, you have the option of filing a complaint with a supervisory authority. A list of supervisory authorities is available on [the website of the European Commission](#).

Right to decide the fate of your personal data after your death

Finally, you have the right to organize the fate of your personal post-mortem data by adopting general or specific guidelines. CentraleSupélec undertakes to respect these directives. In the absence of directives, CentraleSupélec recognizes the heirs the possibility of exercising certain rights, in particular the right of access, if it is necessary for the settlement of the estate of the deceased; and the right to object to close the user accounts of the deceased and oppose the processing of their data.

CentraleSupélec is committed to responding to you as soon as possible, and in any case within one month of receiving your request.

If necessary, this period may be extended by two months, given the complexity and the number of requests addressed to CentraleSupélec. In this case, you will be informed of this extension and the reasons for the postponement.

If your application is submitted electronically, the information will also be provided to you electronically where possible, unless You expressly request otherwise.

If CentraleSupélec does not respond to your request, it will inform you of the reasons for its inaction and you have the possibility to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority and / or to file a judicial appeal.
